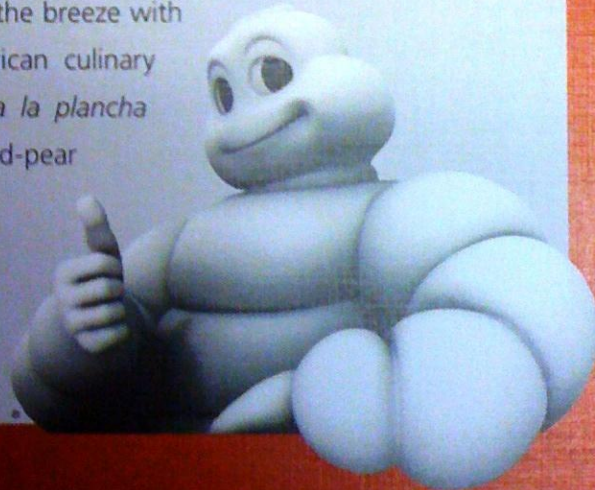

Danville's The Peasant & The Pear nods to the original Parisian bistro, where simple slow cooked foods were served in a modest setting. Within these buttery walls adorned with a few framed photos and dark wood wainscoting, locals get their fill of double cut pork chops and Chianti-braised lamb shank with provolone polenta.

Like a traditional bistro, The Peasant & The Pear feels as familiar as the well-worn dining room of a favorite relative. The petite zinc bar is an easy perch to sip and gab with Chef/owner Rodney Worth as your charming host. When not in the kitchen, he can be found shooting the breeze with regulars who appreciate his American culinary accent in such dishes as prawns *a la plancha* and quesadilla with Brie and spiced-pear chutney.



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
